Trial Achievements over the past year

- * 30th March 2020 - GP practices urged to join COVID-19 research.
- * 17th April 2020 - PRINCIPLE recruited first participant.
- * 12th May 2020 - PRINCIPLE trial rolled out across UK homes and communities.
- * 3rd August 2020 - PRINCIPLE and ZOE partner to widen access to trial.
- * 18th September 2020 - Lloyds Pharmacy and Well Pharmacy join PRINCIPLE Trial.
- * **18th November 2020 - 2000 Participants!**
- * 25th January 2021 - Azithromycin & Doxycycline are not generally effective against COVID-19 in patients treated at home.
- * **3rd February 2021 - 4000 Participants!**
- * 3rd March 2021 - Trial widens to under 50's and adds Colchicine.
