## **Colchicine Arm Has Stopped**

Please note that with **immediate effect**, recruitment to the colchicine arm of the trial has been stopped.

The Trial Steering Committee (TSC) has advised that there is **no beneficial effect** of colchicine for the treatment of COVID-19.

There are **no safety concerns** noted – the stop is due to lack of effectiveness.

Why did you get into research?



## I got into research after being made redundant by my previous employer as I wanted to change career direction.
