- * swelling
- * diarrhoea
- * headache
- * Henoch-Schönlein purpura
- * nausea/vomiting
- * hypersensitivity
- * chest pains
- * rash
- * difficulty breathing
- * low blood pressure
- * swelling of lower legs or hand
- * abnormally rapid heart rate

Appendix 3

Inhaled Corticosteroid - Budesonide

Drug Information

Budesonide is a widely used inhaled corticosteroid used to treat asthma symptoms, but is not currently used to treat infections like COVID-19.

Side-effects

The common side effects are:

- * cough immediately after inhaling
- * mouth and throat pain
- * hoarse voice
- * oral candidiasis (thrush).
